AT THIS TIME THE MATTER OF AN APPEAL REQUEST FROM OFFICER JARVIS LARRY IS DISCUSSED.

OFFICER LARRY IS APPEALING A ONE DAY SUSPENSION FOR VIOLATION OF BOSSIER CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT CODE OF CONDUCT, SECTION 6-DERELICTION OF DUTY, PARAGRAPH B AND BOSSIER CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT COURT ATTENDANCE PROCEDURE GENERAL ORDER 09-04, SECTION 11 A, 2.

ON NOVEMBER 10, 2015, OFFICER LARRY WAS NEEDED TO TESTIFY IN CITY COURT. SEVERAL ATTEMPTS WERE MADE TO LOCATE OFFICER LARRY, HOWEVER, THE ATTEMPTS WERE UNSUCCESSFUL AND THE COURT CASE WAS DISMISSED. IN ADDITION, ON SEPTEMBER 22, 2015, OFFICER LARRY FAILED TO SHOW UP FOR COURT AND THE CASE WAS DISMISSED. ON BOTH OCCASSIONS, THERE WAS NOT ANY EVIDENCE OF A REQUEST BY OFFICER LARRY TO BE EXCUSED FROM COURT.

ON NOVEMBER 11, 2015, LT. GARY AGUIRRE BEGAN AN INTERNAL AFFAIRS INVESTIGATION INTO THIS COMPLAINT. HIS INVESTIGATION FOUND THAT THE COMPLAINT IS SUSTAINED AGAINST OFFICER LARRY FOR FAILING TO APPEAR IN CITY COURT.

ALL PARTIES WERE NOTIFIED OF OFFICER LARRY'S APPEAL REQUEST.

OFFICER LARRY WAS ADVISED HIS APPEAL REQUEST WOULD BE ADDED TO THE BOARD'S AGENDA FOR THE JANUARY 20, 2016, BOARD MEETING AND THE BOARD AT THIS TIME WOULD SET HIS APPEAL HEARING DATE.

#### VIII. APPEAL HEARINGS

##### 1. DOCKET 2015-01, POLICE OFFICER JAMES T. WOOD, IV, vs THE CITY OF BOSSIER CITY

OFFICER WOOD WAS NOTIFIED SEPTEMBER 17, 2015, HE WAS BEING SUSPENDED FOR FIVE CALENDAR DAYS FOR VIOLATION OF BOSSIER CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT CODE OF CONDUCT, SECTION 6, DERELICTION OF DUTY, PARAGRAPH I-FOR NEGLECT OF DUTY:

ON AUGUST 6, 2015, OFFICER WOOD WAS ASSIGNED TO AN ARMED ROBBERY SURVEILLANCE DETAIL. LT. K.T. HUMPHREY, EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF THE CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION DIVISION, ASSIGNED AN AREA TO OFFICER WOOD FOR THIS SURVEILLANCE AND TOLD OFFICER WOOD AND BOSSIER PARISH SHERIFF'S DEPUTY ERIN TINDALL TO CONDUCT SURVEILLANCE IN SEPARATE VEHICLES.

LT. HUMPHREY ALSO EMPHASIZED THAT HOTELS AND MOTELS WERE THE FOCUS OF THE ARMED ROBBERY SURVEILLANCE. SUBSEQUENTLY, AT APPROXIMATELY 1:58 AM. ON AUGUST 7, 2015, TWO SUSPECTS ROBBED THE HILTON HOMEWOOD SUITES, 2015, OLD MINDEN ROAD. THIS BUSINESS WAS IN THE AREA ASSIGNED TO OFFICER WOOD FOR SURVEILLANCE.

BY NOT FOLLOWING LT. HUMPHREY'S INSTRUCTIONS, OFFICER WOOD FAILED TO OBSERVE THE ARMED ROBBERY AND THE SUSPECTS FLED THE SCENE.

LT. HUMPHREY ALSO CALLED OFFICER WOOD ON THE POLICE RADIO SEVERAL TIMES WHEN THE ARMED ROBBERY CALL WAS DISPATCHED TO PATROL OFFICERS AND OFFICER WOOD DID NOT RESPOND IN AN APPROPRIATE LENGTH OF TIME.

ON AUGUST 10, 2015, SERGEANT MICHAEL WILLIAMS BEGAN AN INTERNAL AFFAIRS INVESTIGATION INTO THIS COMPLAINT. HIS INVESTIGATION FOUND THAT THIS COMPLAINT IS SUSTAINED AGAINST OFFICER WOOD FOR FAILING TO FOLLOW ORDERS AND FAILING TO ANSWER THE POLICE RADIO IN A TIMELY MANNER.

ON SEPTEMBER 21, 2015, OFFICER WOOD FILED AN APPEAL REQUEST BY HIS LEGAL ADVISOR MS. PAM BREEDLOVE.

ALL PARTIES WERE NOTIFIED OF THE APPEAL REQUEST.

ON SEPTEMBER 30, 2015, THIS BOARD SET OFFICER WOOD'S APPEAL REQUEST FOR NOVEMBER 11, 2015.

ON SEPTEMBER 9, 2015, MR. TRULY McDANIEL, ASSISTANT CITY ATTORNEY FOR THE CITY OF BOSSIER CITY, REQUESTED THIS BOARD RESCHEDULE THIS HEARING.

ON SEPTEMBER 10, 2015, THIS BOARD RECEIVED CORRESPONDENCE FROM MS. BREEDLOVE AND MR. McDANIEL REQUESTING THE BOARD RESCHEDULE THE APPEAL HEARING.
