ORDINANCE NO. 56 OF 2022

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A CONDITIONAL USE FOR THE SALE OF HIGH AND LOW CONTENT ALCOHOL FOR ON PREMISE CONSUMPTION AT A RESTAURANT LOCATED AT 2950 EAST TEXAS STREET, (EXHIBIT A ATTACHED) BOSSIER CITY, LOUISIANA.

WHEREAS; Darren Balsamo, Surge Bossier, has applied to the Bossier City-Parish Metropolitan Planning Commission for Conditional Use Approval for the retail sale of high and low content alcohol, for on premise consumption with conditions, at a restaurant located at 2950 East Texas Street (Exhibit A Attached), Bossier City, Louisiana.

WHEREAS; a public hearing for the Conditional Use application was held on April 11, 2022; and

WHEREAS; The Planning Department has submitted the results of said public hearing to the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Bossier City.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOSSIER CITY HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. That the Conditional Use for retail sales of high and low content alcohol for on premise consumption at 2950 East Texas Street, (Exhibit A Attached), Bossier City, Louisiana is hereby approved with the condition that Surge must provide security by 2 off duty Bossier City Police Officers during the time of 5:00 PM to midnight on Friday and Saturday evenings; 3:00 PM to 10 PM on Sundays and alcohol must stay in the section where served.
